Yesterday evening they boarded the flight to Lima with bubbling excitement, headed for a couple more weeks of paperwork in Lima and then on to their new home. We praise the Lord for working out every detail of the case.

Yesterday evening was doubly eventful as Benjamin also left Morningstar. His life began with his parents dumping him on top of a garbage heap on the edge of town when he was but a day old. Shortly thereafter he became the center of attention in Morningstar's House #1, where he was doted on and spoiled rotten for then next 6 months. The judge handling his case assigned custody to a nice young couple from Chiclayo who have been faithfully visiting him this whole time. We thank the Lord that he is now enjoying what will be a permanent family situation.
