At a team meeting on a Friday the question was posed, “What happens when Morningstar is full and one of the family courts requests we take in a child temporarily, can they be housed briefly at one of the missionaries’ houses for a few days”? The answer was “Yes”, it has been done in the past. The very next Tuesday one of the family court judges called to request a 5 day stay for not one but three little brothers. Badly neglected and abused, they had spent one night at a shelter downtown but they urgently needed some TLC. Since there is no room available at Morning Star the only option was the Dejager’s house. Kim and their three children have been caring for Nain, Jorge & Edwin since the beginning of November. They extended the option beyond the first five days much to the delight of the judge. The courts have been closed for the entire month due to a workers strike and there is no certainty of possible alternatives, so they continue in the Dejager’s care until some other arrangement can be worked out.

Work began this week on the slab on which the two new classrooms for Strong Tower Christian School.
