3 Day Campout – Taking advantage of the school vacations that coincide with the Peruvian Independence Day holidays, all the children in Morning Star except the youngest, (Daniel & Sarah) were taken on a camping trip to a farm about an hour away. The farm belongs to a friend of Tom & Carol who besides growing sugar cane also raises Paso Fino thoroughbred show horses. One of the days they visited a nearby recreational facility which because of its location further up the valley enjoys more balmy weather and the pool was the main attraction. The kids had an excellent time and returned exhausted but very happy.



Strong Tower Visitation Program – One of the primary goals of the Strong Tower School is to be able to access the homes of the families whose children attend there. This goal is being achieved by the visits that have begun by several of the couples associated with the ministry here. A small survey is done on the first visit and the last question is “Would you like to study the Bible on a regular basis with the help of someone from the church”? Virtually every family has said “Yes” so far! Only half the families have been visited so far but there are almost 20 weekly studies now scheduled and ongoing where the gospel is being shared in these homes. Please pray for seed of the gospel that is being planted in their hearts.

Daniel’s Progress – A couple of weeks after his surgery the surgeon being very pleased with the healing process, instructed us to begin the dilations using the Hager dilators Tom was able to secure in Florida.
