Audrey DeJager spent 28 years working in Senegal and upon returning to her native Canada began seeking the Lord's direction as to where she could refocus her ministry. Her brother Mark and his family had moved to Chiclayo a year ago and would be taking over the administration of the Strong Tower Christian School here. She visited for three weeks in April and decided that this was where the Lord was leading her. That decision was confirmed after meeting with her local church leadership and she arrived in Peru August 31, this time to stay! She will be teaching English at Strong Tower. We welcome her and are excited to see the Lord filling the staffing needs of the ministry here.

Omar is 9 years old. He has been bounced around from family member to family member, hasn't seen his parents in several years. The aunts and uncles he has most recently been living with chose to deal with his manipulative behavior in some pretty violent ways and he had fled the home due to the beatings. The neighbors whose house he wandered into far from home took him to the police station and the family court judge called to see if there was any way Morning Star could squeeze him in. There are definite behavior patterns that need to be reprogrammed but his willingness to try and please are evident and we are confident the Lord can work in his heart and set him on the right path.



Yolanda is a single mom that lives a few blocks from Morning Star. She has a 4 year old daughter who has an orthopedic condition affecting her right leg. She lives next door to Rosa Santamaria whose is a teacher's aide at Strong Tower and has been in fellowship in our congregation for several years along with her family. Rosa invited her to Sunday School last week, Yolanda in her own words "was searching for God because her circumstances were becoming too much for her". After listening to the lesson she asked if she could accept Christ as her Savior. It reminds us of the essential simplicity of the gospel message... when at the end of ourselves we turn to Him who has been pursuing us by His grace! We thank the Lord for each new soul **HE** brings into His kingdom and we thank you for your prayers on behalf of the ministry here!
