While it is certainly a challenge keep up with all the details especially while short on staff, it is encouraging to know you are praying for us. We especially value your prayers for continued wisdom in the day to day tasks. We feel the time has come to take on someone to share in the administrative duties as well as one more full time caregiver as many of our staff have not had vacation time as yet this year. Peruvian labor laws provide for one months paid vacation each year and with the COVID lockdown in place for many months of 2020, it has not be feasible to give anyone time off. Please pray for the Lord to bring the right people to fill those gaps.



The children's education has certainly been a test of endurance with changes and adjustments made often along the way. It feels like the entire education system is groping it's way through a hithertofore unknown maze, however the kids have stepped up and along with our courageous staff have been making good progress. They are however looking forward to a short break in the summer which will run from Christmas to about the middle of January.
