Summer is primarily a change of pace.....school is out but 20 kids need structure day to day and so we implement our own "summer school" each morning. They can always learn and prepare for the next school year which begins in March. Still in "pandemic mode", they will continue remote classes until the government decides they can return to on site classes.



We keep three classrooms running all morning, kindergarten, primary and highschool. The kids all rotate through daily house chores and also participate in kitchen prep and clean-up. However, summer is of course also supposed to be fun! Afternoons are devoted to games and outdoor activities. The pool is a favorite of course and the playground is the center of activity. We are able to program special birthday celebrations as they come up and we are very thankful the Lord has continued to bless us all with good health and has provided for all of our needs.



We round out the schedule with some special activities, organized games, some special outings and one on one Bible Study and discipleship. Weekends are interesting as the government continues to change up the rules as to whether the church can meet or not, but Sundays are always special, with time for worship, Sunday School, a visit to our library to check out books for the week and special meals in the dining hall which includes a time of singing and devotional on Sunday evenings.

The schedule is packed and there is much to accomplish each day. We are in the process of renewing our government accreditation and keeping up with legal paperwork for all of the kids, but it's most important to remember that all of them require personal attention, and to feel they are valued, loved and heard. It is a difficult balance to maintain however we are thankful that the Lord provides wisdom, guidance and grace each day as needed.
