The month of June was quite eventful for us at Morning Star. Sixteen year old Fatima had been with us for 8 months and her older sister was granted custody of her after several postponements. She is happily reunited with her family now and we are thankful that during that time she recognized that she had previously accepted Christ as her Savior but had drifted into friendships that were not helpful. Her renewed commitment to the Lord led to her baptism while at Morning Star and we were able to see her spiritual growth as she was disciplined by our co-worker Crystal. Follow up will be important and we ask for your prayers on her behalf.

Katy turned six! She has been at Morning Star half of her life! She and her sister Romy are two of 9 siblings whose mentally challenged mother cannot care for them, however the judge in their case was dragging her feet in making a decision regarding their future. After the judge was reprimanded by her superiors

for the delay. we were thrilled to receive the final ruling in their case this month meaning they will now move into the adoption process and we ask you to pray the Lord will provide them with a family in the near future.

With a suprisingly similar backstory, two other sisters, Juanita and Mia have been with us since December of 2018. Their case was also before the same judge and their final ruling came along just a few days after Romy and Katy's. Both sets of sisters are ages 6 and 9 and we are praying for an expedited adoption process in their cases.

We continually see the need to expand the capacity here at Morning Star. Please pray with us as the Lord has seen fit to provide resources that will allow us to retrofit some of our existing classroom footage into living quarters that in His time will allow us to open House #3.
