The children at Morning Star look forward to their birthdays for months. They get to choose their favorite meal for lunch and are of course the center of attention when it comes time to open presents and cut the cake. Mia turned 6 this month and was the only August birthday.



Guadalupe had been with us 16 months while Child Protective Services worked through preparing her family to regain custody. She was very happy to be going home. Please pray for the seed sown in her heart to bring about spiritual fruit in the future.

This month for the first time since Morning Star opened in 2006 we had a RUNNER! Grecia had only been with us since last month and halfway through Wednesday night prayer meetings, bolted for the open door onto the street. Tom caught up to her 3 blocks away and had brought her back, but it became apparent

she was not going to be very cooperative in the future. Child Protective Services decided to award custody to her mother as we made it clear other options had to be explored. While she's only 14, she'd already been accustomed to living virtually unsupervised and we pray that the exposure to the Gospel during her short time at Morning Star would get her to reconsider some of her life choices.



Both the kindergarten and high school classes have been moved into their newly remodeled rooms and so now we can begin to convert the adjoining classrooms they vacated into housing. Please continue to pray for this project that will allow us to add 7-8 new beds in what will be our third house.
